During this general membership meeting, we will have the opportunity to hear from Katy Greenleaf, a local mental health professional, who will be speaking on positive parenting through connection. Parenting is such hard work. Regardless of each child's unique behaviors or needs, guiding humans through the ups and downs of infancy, childhood, adolescence, and young adulthood can be both exhilarating and exhausting. This is even more challenging when you have highly sensitive or intelligent children. Katy will speak about how to use connection, curiosity, (emotion) coaching, and (building) compassion to help our kids learn from life's challenges and grow up to be flexible, resilient, and adaptable adults.
